Tokyo Metropolitan University (TMU) offers a 3-week Japanese summer course in 2019. The program aims at providing a comprehensive introduction to Japanese language and culture. Students will develop their language skills, experience Japanese culture, and increase their understanding of the Japanese society.

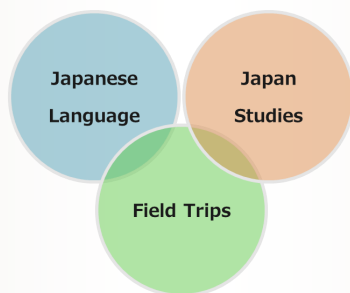


### Where is TMU?

Tokyo Metropolitan University is the only public university in Tokyo. Minami-Osawa, where the main campus is located, is in the western part of Tokyo. TMU is very accessible from the central area such as Shinjuku and Shibuya (40 min by train), and also a direct bus service operates between Minami-Osawa and the Narita and Haneda airports.

### PROGRAM CONTENTS

The 3-week program covers Japanese language study, Japan studies (will be taught in English) and field trips.



### PROGRAM LEVEL

The Japanese language classes at three levels (Survival Japanese, Basic Japanese, and Pre-intermediate) are designed for students who want to start studying Japanese or want to accelerate their language study in the intensive program.

- ◆ Survival Japanese: An introductory course in Japanese, intended for students who have no previous knowledge of Japanese
- ◆ Basic Japanese: Intended for students who have studied Japanese and have mastered hiragana, katakana and some kanji (JLPT N5; CEFR A1)
- ◆ Pre-intermediate: For students who have completed basic-level Japanese and have mastered the basic skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing (JLPT N4 preparatory level; CEFR A2-B1)
