

**CRITERIA OF SELECTION
COMMISSION MOB-LIL-EX****1. GENERAL CRITERIA**

- Eligibility and completeness of files for study cycles (BUT; Master/Engineer; Doctorate).
- The MOBILEX grant cannot be *combined with Erasmus+, MIC, AMI, MERMOZ grants (study/internship or research), Doctoral College and Graduate Program grants. Any student eligible for one of these schemes is not eligible for the MOBILEX scholarship.*
- Possibility to benefit from the Moblilex scholarship **once per cycle of studies (BUT-/Master/Innovator); Doctorate).**
- Reasoned opinion and classification of the components, laboratories, and doctoral schools (*any unclassified file that does not include a reasoned opinion will not be reviewed and will be immediately rejected*)
- For **incoming mobility**: students and doctoral candidates must be on the move (students and doctoral candidates already present in Lille are not eligible).
- Priority given to mobility within **the framework of existing and structuring cooperations (bilateral agreement, IRL (International Research Laboratory) research cooperation agreement, double-degree...)**
- The Moblilex budget will be allocated as follows:

CONDITION1: at least 60% of the total budget of the call will be allocated to applications related to partner universities, members of our networks or alliances mentioned below:

CONDITION 2: a maximum of 40% of the total call budget will be dedicated to applications related to institutions not included in the above list.

- **The selected files will be financed by Neurotech's budget and not by Mobillex.**

2. SPECIFIC CRITERIA APPLIED TO MASTER/ENGINEER LEVEL MOBILITY

INCOMING MOBILITIES:

- Priority to students considering a thesis project at the University of Lille (please add a one-page description of the project, specifying the identified research director and research team)

3. SPECIFIC CRITERIA APPLIED TO DOCTORAL-LEVEL MOBILITY

The reasoned opinion justifying the classification of the file by the EG must take into account in particular:

- The progress of the thesis
- The relevance of displacement at this stage of the thesis progress
- The existence of structuring cooperation for work and/or for the research unit and/or for the university where the move is envisaged. Ex. formal or informal partnerships, ongoing or future, actual or potential (joint supervision; IRN, IRP; other research programs)
- Whether the doctoral student receives funding or not
- Sincerity and reasonableness of the budget

INCOMING MOBILITIES:

ATTENTION: MOBILEX is a mobility grant that cannot be used as thesis funding but allows for the financing of necessary mobilities during the thesis.

- Final MOBILEX ranking carried out and reported by the Graduate **Schools**.
- For incoming doctoral mobility, the MOBILEX scholarship will be primarily awarded to PhD students in cotutelle (agreement finalized or under development)
- Taking into account the year of enrollment in thesis (only doctoral students enrolled in the first, second, and third years are funded, or with an exemption and a reasoned opinion for the fourth year)

OUTBOUND MOBILITIES:

ATTENTION:

- **mobilities of less than 3 months are not eligible and may be the subject of an application to the Doctoral College's programs.**
- Final MOBILEX ranking carried out and reported by the Graduate Schools.
- Taking into account the year of enrollment in thesis (only doctoral students enrolled in the first, second, and third years are funded, or with an exemption and a reasoned opinion for the fourth year)
- For the PhD level, applications eligible for Mermoz Research but not selected following the review of their file by the Region have the opportunity to submit an exceptional application. The requests will be examined by a virtual commission.

4. SPECIFIC CRITERIA APPLIED TO OUTGOING SHORT-TERM MOBILITIES (INSPÉ/ SANTÉ)

Short-term mobility is intended for students from the INSPÉ and/or health sector wishing to undertake a short-term international mobility.

The reasoned opinion justifying the classification of the file by **the main component** must take into account in particular:

- Internship agreement signed by the various parties involved/ study contract
- The duration of mobility must not exceed 3 months.
- Priority to be given to mandatory mobilities
